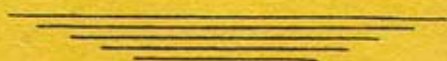

N.M.L.R.A. SCORING RULES

(Revised Sept. 7, 1941)

1. All shots shall be scored from center of bullet hole and not from the break of the bullet or outside of hole.
2. The shooter having fewest shots of lowest value shall be declared the winner in case of a tie.
3. Any match where prone (or rest) and offhand positions are required, the shooters having the best score in the offhand position shall be declared winner in the aggregate.
4. The shooter having the best score at the longest range, where an aggregate of scores shot over two or more ranges are required, shall be declared the winner.
5. Rules of the National Rifle Association shall prevail except where they conflict with the above rules.

### RANGE RULES

1. The Range Officer shall have full authority on the firing line.
2. The Executive Officer may rule on any unexpected event.
3. No piece shall be capped or primed until the competitor is in firing position.
4. No loaded piece may be taken from the firing line.
5. No competitor or coach may step forward of the firing line to load or clean piece.
6. If a competitor has any difficulties he should call the Range Officer immediately.
7. The use of intoxicating liquor on the firing line shall be considered ample cause for disqualification.
8. Should a competitor desire to protest a score or the value of any shot he shall accompany the protest with a fifty (50c) cents fee; in the event the competitor is ruled to be in the right, the fee will be returned.

### Range Rules (Cont'd)

9. Offhand Position—This means extended arm supporting the piece, no part of the supporting arm to touch the body; the piece must (in case of a rifle) rest in the palm of the hand not on the finger tips except in Scheutzen matches, where Free Rifle may be used.
10. Open Sights—Rear open sight is one where the opening is a "u," "v" or rectangular opening, as wide at the top as at any other part of the sight. Front—May be a blade, pinhead post or barley-corn.
11. A competitor delayed by a mechanical defect of piece may be allowed to finish in a later relay, but his time will not be extended. Fouling of the bore will not be considered a mechanical defect.
12. Butt of the rifle must be supported by some part of the body.
13. Smoking will not be permitted on the firing line.
